Abstract: Alfonso Ugarte's work can be classified as belonging to a phase of musical regeneration. The originators of this movement in Basque and Navarran territory were certain first-line figures (Guridi, Aita Donostia, etc.), but also certain important local musicians. This work includes Ugarte's role as the promoter of the reform of sacred music, musical nationalism and the movement of musical bands.
