Poet, chronicler and Regional Government archivist, he brought together his more literary and historic facet in the defence of Navarrese liberty. All his efforts were rewarded during the transient surge of enthusiasm in regional jurisdiction, the Gamazada. He ended up retiring to his house of Auritz/Burguete.
