As you know, the great Spanish musicologist and scholar, Dr. E.M. Turner, died recently in a London hospital.

Retiring by nature and handicapped by the difficulty of a foreign language, Dr. Turner spent in England fifteen years of poverty. Indifferent to material hardships and failing health, he worked right to the end collecting material for a comprehensive study of themes common to both popular and literary Spanish poetry. His wife and daughter are now left in great economic distress.

Knowing that many of Dr. Turner's friends and admirers would like to help his family in this moment of need, we are inviting contributions for this purpose. We hope to collect enough funds to allow Dr. Turner's wife and daughter to tide over a very difficult period.
