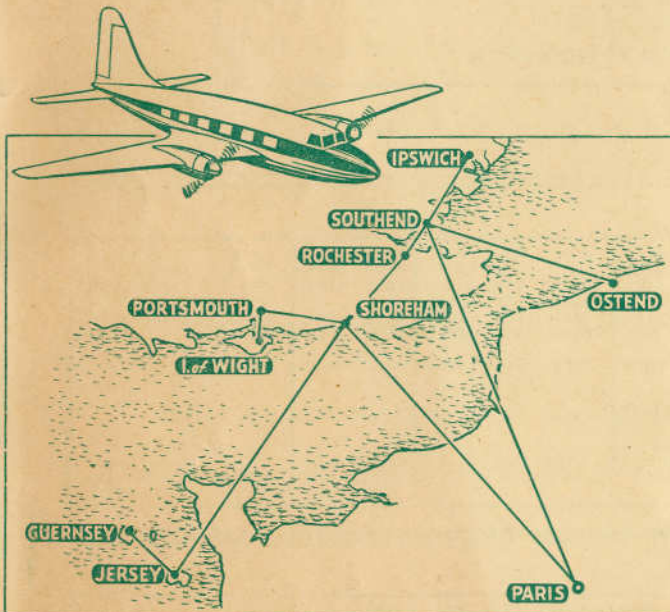

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS

Conditions of Carriage and Regulations

The carriage of passengers, baggage and cargo is subject to E.A.F.S.'s General Conditions of Carriage and Regulations, which may be seen on request at any E.A.F.S. Office. The notes below are for general guidance and reference should be made to the appropriate Condition or Regulation for full details.

RESERVATIONS: Please reserve your seat as far in advance as possible through any E.A.F.S. Booking Office or Agent.

CANCELLATIONS: If you have to cancel or change your reservation, please give notice quickly as there are time limits after which it may not be possible for a refund to be made.

CHILDREN: One child under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat, is carried at 10 per cent. of the adult fare. Additional children under two years and children of two years and under nine years of age are carried at half the adult fare.

TICKETS: Your ticket contains important information concerning your journey; please examine it carefully.

PASSPORTS & VISAS: E.A.F.S. or its Agents will gladly provide information regarding Passports, Travel Permits or Visas when required for your journey, but you must ensure personally that these documents are in order, because the carrier cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of any irregularity. You will have to show your passport or permit during your journey, so please carry it with you; do not pack it.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES: Certain countries require valid certificates of inoculation and/or vaccination. Please enquire well in advance whether any such certificates are needed for your journey.

CURRENCY CONTROL: The movement of money into and out of many countries is subject to Government control and you should consult your Travel Agent or Bank about regulations applicable to your journey well before the date of travel.

BAGGAGE: Free Allowances: For an adult or for a child paying half the adult fare the free allowance is 30lbs. Personal Items: In addition to the free allowance, the following may be carried free of charge: a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, a foot rug, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars and a reasonable amount of reading-matter for the flight.

Brief cases, typewriters and large cameras have to be included in the baggage weights under the regulations of the International Air Transport Association.

GENERAL INFORMATION (Cont'd.)

EXCESS: Baggage in excess of the allowance may be carried subject to space being available, at the appropriate rates.

Unaccompanied Baggage: You can send unaccompanied baggage at normal cargo rates.

Prohibition Articles: Government regulations do not permit the carriage of inflammable or explosive material on aircraft and you are asked not to carry in your baggage articles which are easily ignited, such as cigarette lighter fluid, matches other than safety matches.

N.B. Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry commercial samples provided you arrange to be at the airport not later than the time specified by the local Customs, in the United Kingdom this is 40 minutes before aircraft departure time.

CAMERAS: On international journeys cameras must be packed in your registered baggage which is not taken into the cabin with you.

INSURANCE: You can purchase Personal and Baggage Insurance at E.A.F.S. Offices in the United Kingdom and in most countries abroad. Please ask for details.

DEPARTURES: On your ticket you will find in addition to the aircraft departure times, an indication as to how long before these times it is essential for passengers to assemble, in order to allow the embarkation formalities to be completed. Departure cannot be delayed for passengers who arrive late and E.A.F.S. cannot accept responsibility in such cases.

PUNCTUALITY: Every effort is made to ensure punctuality of our services, but E.A.F.S. cannot accept responsibility for the consequences of a delay to, or a cancellation of, any service and cannot guarantee making connections.

ANIMALS: We are sorry that we cannot carry any animal in the passenger cabin or as baggage.

It is impossible in the space available here to give more than an outline of points for your guidance. Your Travel Agent or any E.A.F.S. Office will gladly supply additional information and offer you every possible assistance in connection with your journey.

Dear Sir,

The British Railways' General Agent in Paris advises that you have applied to him for extension of validity of a second-class London-Paris ticket portion and that Agent states that you were advised to apply to him.

As there is no trace of an application from you to my Office, I would confirm that the decision to extend rests with this Department, and further, that such extension is only granted where the postponement of journey was the result of distress, such as illness.

If, therefore, you will let me have a Doctor's certificate I will be pleased to arrange the desired extension, but if you are unable to meet the requirement, I can only then suggest that you purchase a fresh ticket for the London-Paris journey and apply, on arrival in Paris, for refund on the unused portion of the original ticket, in which event the original ticket should be officially endorsed as 'unused' by my Office.
